Staff-in-Training Job Descriptions
(Must be at least 17 years old.)

Primary Duties:

- Each summer staff member should endeavor to lead a Eucharistic lifestyle-being broken open and poured out to serve others, take the time to worship, take time to be still and silent and allow the Holy Spirit to fill you to overflowing in order to continue serving.
- To treat everyone you encounter this summer as Christ-to love, accept, listen to, be there for, whatever is needed in someone else.
- Assist full time summer staff in helping lead and process activities, adventure and aquatic, at camp, ensuring the safety of each participant.
- Will work alongside the full time summer staff to help plan and lead prayer, worship and faith development aspects of the camp program.
- When necessary, be available to serve as counselors for each camp.
- Help other volunteer staff, other summer staff and other full-time staff in any way needed.
- Help with set up and clean up for breakfast, lunch, dinner and snacks for all camps.
- Conduct themselves in a manner befitting the Catholic Church, the Gasper River Catholic Youth Camp & Retreat Center, the Bishop of the Diocese of Owensboro, their families, and themselves.
- Spend as much time with the campers as possible when not leading an activity.
- Will have completed the Safe Environment Program and back ground check required by the Diocese of Owensboro.
- Will serve one to two weeks at a time, depending of availability and will meet with the camp director about the possibility of additional weeks.

Secondary Duties:

- Help with maintenance of the buildings and grounds at Gasper River Catholic Youth Camp & Retreat Center.
- Help with office work, mailings, etc. when needed.
- Complete any other tasks that the director or program director deems necessary for camp.
